- Invites are strictly for children aged 3 to 16 years. Only ONE child can attend on each invitation and must be accompanied by a responsible adult. Each child's invite entitles ONE adult entry.
- Catering will be provided for the child only. Parents and carers may purchase refreshments from George's Café, The Fig Tree Café, and the Kiosk at the Immersion Exhibit or bring a picnic lunch. The Coffee Club will be supplying free Coffee for all in attendance!
- The Zoo will be closed to the public until 2pm at which time entry will be at ½ price should other family members wish to join you.
- Wheelchairs and prams will not be provided or be available for hire, if needed you will need to bring them with you.
- Guide / Assistance Dogs may enter the front gate and are given a suitable area with shelter and water while you're in attendance. Guide / Assistance Dogs are not allowed through the zoo as it is a quarantine zone.
- The Adelaide Zoo is a SMOKE FREE venue and the Christmas Party for Special Children is an alcohol free event.

Dementia Friendly Communities

2017 Dementia Friendly Communities Progress Update

In 2017 the aim was to change the focus of the Dementia Friendly Communities committee from awareness raising to providing Dementia Friendly audited spaces in already existing Businesses, Community & Health Centres, which will be areas that are inclusive & safe, where those living with Dementia are able to go without fear or rejection, intimidation, and where their condition is understood.

There has been a broadening of the Dementia friendly communities committee membership and includes; Residential Aged Care, Service Clubs, Health Professionals and Local Council. Introduction of new committee members brings;

> A broader community involvement, An expansion of knowledge and more ideas and resources to support the goals and activities of the group

The committee will always be steered by carers whose objectives are the primary focus of the committee.

DFC Assessment of the Barossa Council

On the 15th June, The Barossa Council; was the first organisation in the region to undergo an assessment using the Dementia Friendly Communities Assessment Tool.

The assessment was to view the main entrance of the Council Chambers in Nuriootpa and the Library entrance in relation to the Dementia Friendly



Communities design principles. An assessment was conducted by Matt Kowald (General Manager, Barossa Village), Bev Saegenschnitter (DFC

Project Coordinator), an Occupational Therapist, a Council Representative, a carer and a person with Dementia (pictured above). 15 recommendations were developed for The Barossa Council to address.

Audit/Assessment training 18th May 2017 @ The Council Chambers

Matt Kowald conducted a session at the Barossa Council Chambers in Nuriootpa reviewing the tools that could be applied in the review of spaces for people with Dementia. We discussed the application of the environmental screening tools and discussed the importance of reviewing the environment in context that the person with dementia will be engaging with the space. All agreed that the most important part of the space is not necessarily the environmental factors but the staff engagement factors. Matt is working on an instructional video which would provide basic engagement strategies and scenarios which would be given to the staff to view. We would be doing this as a YouTube video with the questions answered be the people watching the video.

The next step would be to conduct an audit of the space. This is going to be down at the Barossa Council for the entrance foyer and library. This will be conducted by Matt Kowald and Mirium Popoinski, OT at Barossa Village. It was discussed that this would be best done with a consumer. This report would help inform the redesign of the space.

<u>Out & About,</u> Spreading the Word



DFC & Carer Support

On Wed 19th July Brent Bennett and Bev Saegenschnitter were guest speakers for a gathering of 24 people for the Eudunda Probus group in the Eudunda Institute. Brent spoke about his role for Carers & Disability Link as a Carer Support Worker that provides information about navigating the aged care system and facilitating support groups which enables carers to have some "time out" from their caring role with other carers. This was supported by Bev Saegenschnitter about her personal story, when she became involved with Carers & Disability Link, 14 years ago, when she had a need to be involved with a carers support group, a place that she could find comfort reassurance be understood amongst others that were on a similar journey. Bev then spoke about her role for Carers & Disability Link, as Project Coordinator for the "Dementia Friendly Communities" committee. Bev gave a brief overview about Dementia and some of the associated myth, along with the purpose of the Dementia Friendly Communities committee, which are to break down the barriers and stigma, with acceptance, independence, inclusion. Opportunities to educate in our community sectors, organisations like Probus will be more equipped with their knowledge and embrace the change for those people living with Dementia and their families.




